If you have **additional materials** beyond the report that you would like to send (such as photos or maps), you can email these as a pdf to eireporting@forestsociety.org. Be sure to reference the property name in your email.

To print a version of this report, log in, then go to "My Account". In the middle of the page there is an item called "Executory Interest History." Choose that. To the very right of the items you can select for a given property is one called "view." Select that and you will see a summary of the submitted report. If you select that you can print it by hitting command-P and then either print it at that moment or choose to save it as a PDF for later printing.
